



### Notes

#### Reservations

When using your Bus Pass to ride a bus with a reservation, present your ticket and make the reservation at the ticket window.

Reservations cannot be made over the Internet or by phone.

#### Refunds

For refunds before you have received the bus ticket, consult the travel agency where you purchased your voucher. No refunds are provided once you have received the bus ticket, regardless of train or bus suspensions, delays, or lack of available seats.

Purchase condition Limited to those who have a residence card for Japan or a non-Japanese passport.

Usage condition Valid for 3 consecutive days from the date you started to use the ticket, including airport access.
